Teacher Institute of Excellence provides professional development and extended training for Cherokee language teachers associated with Cherokee language programs that are responsible for education while maintaining quality progress in language proficiency and to meet the needs of Cherokee language throughout the 14-county reservation and beyond.

All sessions are held in Tahlequah, OK, Monday through Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm. Instruction will be discussion-based in a Cherokee language immersion environment.

To be selected for the program, the following requirements must be met:

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Must pass a youth-sensitive background check.
- Must be willing to teach different age groups (children to adults).
- Must possess a strong desire to help revitalize the Cherokee language and culture, through teaching.
- Must score high-intermediate or low-advanced in speaking on the approved Cherokee language assessment.
