



Rogers State University Cherokee 1 & 2 Scholarship

The RSU Concurrent Enrollment scholarship is available to high school students who are enrolled in Cherokee 1 or Cherokee 2 at RSU while still in high school. Cherokee Nation will pay tuition and fees. Eligibility criteria are listed below:

- Must be a citizen of the Cherokee Nation
- All Cherokee Nation citizens, in the 14 counties and at-large, are eligible.
- If the student attends a Public High School, the student must submit a verification letter from a school official (showing eligibility)
- If a student is home schooled, the student must submit verification from the individual who is providing home schooling (showing eligibility)
- Student must complete community service hours for every \$100 they receive with a minimum of 1 hour if received less than \$100.
- Students funded for the Fall 2022 semester will need to submit their college transcript showing the Fall 2022 grades.
- All funds will be sent to the university

Deadline:

• Fall 2022 – June 15, 2022

Required documents:

- Application
- High School transcript
- Current schedule from the university
- Recommendation letter from school official
- Counselor Approval Letter
- Parent Approval Letter
